Deck the Halls







Stitch this cute little wall hanging to either deck your own halls or to give as a gift that will be cherished for years to come.

Simple fused baubles hang from sparkly gold thread attached to a thread painted Christmas tree bough.

Make yours to hang in portrait or landscape format or use the technique to make postcards that will delight your friends!

Requirements:

Background fabric in plain or reads-as-plain fabric (sample was made using Moda Grunge). The sample measures 21 x 14 but you could make any size you like*

Stitch and Tear the same size as background fabric (optional)*

An assortment of fabric scraps suitable for use as baubles. The wall hanging won't be washed, so consider using silks, satins, sparkly ribbon, recycled fabrics as well as quilting cotton*

Tiny amount of sparkly fabric for the cap of the baubles*

Small amount of Bondaweb or similar*

Size 80 Topstitch needle. This needle should avoid any issues caused by the threads, so do try to find some*

A small amount of metallic thread. Gold is used in the sample but other colours may suit your fabrics better - or you may choose to use any other thread to "hang" your baubles*

Green polyester machine embroidery thread for the pine bough. * I can suggest a stockist.

* A kit can be provided at a cost of £15
