

Easy Curvylicious Quilt



Curved blocks always look spectacular, but many quilters are nervous of stitching them. Let me help you learn to love your curves!

In this pieced circle workshop, we will look at four different ways to stitch a curve. You will be encouraged to try all four and then pick a favourite. We will also focus on lining up the blocks for perfect circles.

At the end of the class, you will be well on your way to having a wall hanging or baby quilt to be proud of – and you will also have all the skills you need to tackle any kind of curved piecing.

Requirements:

The pieces can be cut from paper templates which I can email you, but it's much easier and more accurate to cut with acrylic rulers which I have produced specifically for this class. It may also be possible for me to provide kits.

Requirements:

Fabric:

1.5 yards background fabric

1.5 yards (total) fabrics for pieced circles. This could be just two fabrics or a whole range of fabrics – I used about 15 fabrics. Scraps are fine (4½" x 5" minimum)

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
